

HARVEST PHOTO COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Promoter of this competition is Ceres Rural LLP, Council Offices, London Road, Saffron Walden, CB11 4ER.
2. This competition is open to individuals aged 18 and over. Employees of the Promoter, its associated businesses, their immediate families, agents, or anyone professionally connected with the competition are not eligible to enter.
3. To enter the competition, participants must submit a photograph taken during Harvest 2026 via the official online entry form.
4. Participants may submit multiple photographs; however, the Promoter reserves the right to limit the number of entries considered from any one individual and to remove duplicate or inappropriate submissions.
5. By entering the competition, participants confirm that:
 - They are the creator and copyright holder of the submitted photograph(s).
 - They have permission from any identifiable individuals featured in the photograph(s).
 - The submitted photograph(s) do not infringe the rights of any third party.
6. The Promoter reserves the right to reject any entry that it considers inappropriate, offensive, misleading, unlawful, or otherwise unsuitable for the competition.
7. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, corrupted, misdirected, incomplete, or unable to be submitted due to technical reasons or circumstances beyond its control.
8. The closing date for entries is 9th August 2026. Entries received after this date will not be considered. The Competition winner will be chosen by the 14th August 2026.
9. Competition entries will be reviewed by a judging panel appointed by the Promoter. The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the outcome.
10. The winning photograph will receive a gift box from The Venison Company. Should the prize become unavailable for any reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute it with a prize of equal or greater value.
11. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any costs associated with the prize that are not specifically included.
12. The winner will be notified by email within 14 days of the judging process being completed. If the winner does not respond within 30 days of notification, the Promoter reserves the right to select an alternative winner.
13. The prize is non-transferable, non-exchangeable, and no cash alternative will be offered.

Photographers will be credited where reasonably practical.

16. The Promoter and its associated agencies and companies accept no responsibility for any loss, damage, liability, injury, or disappointment incurred as a result of entering the competition or accepting the prize, except where liability cannot be excluded by law.
